Family – One adult pays 50% \$87.50, second adult pays \$175, up to two Youths or Children pay \$50 each, 3rd & subsequent children no fee applies. Join fee & Levy applies.

Student - full time, proof of ID required (plus Join fee & Levy)\$100

Work Party Levy for 2025 Adult, Student or Youth \$200 New fee structure contributes to the financial future of the Club whilst rewarding those who put in the hard mahi, by means of work days on the field or off-mountain activities. Fee is waived for those who complete 2 work days (2 Work Party Credits) by 30 April.

Other categories:

Associate – elect to transfer from Adult to Associate (eg if travelling overseas). You stay on the mailing list but no discounts apply for lift / accommodation. \$35

Veteran – applies after 25 years of adult membership \$75

Locker for boots or skis (supply your own padlock, limited number available – please check first) cost \$40 each annually.

Season lift pass

Adult \$560, Youth* \$280 (aged 11 to 17, as at 1 Jan; child under 11 years ski for free). Purchase by May.

FREE Season Pass if you complete 10 approved Work Days & have your application form in by 30 April. Can't do 10 days? – then you'll be able to purchase with a mix of work party days & cash. Pass application forms are sent out with the April members email newsletter for you to record your work days and apply.

Work Days / Work Party Credits

Special rates are available on lift fees with season passes, daily rates, accommodation and ski packages for members who choose to complete Work Days during the summer/autumn – on the field or off-mountain activities. The season is from 1 May to 30 April for calculating your discount. Each Day earns a Credit which can be traded towards discounted levels, eg 6 days gives you 60% off accommodation. **Special offer** - you may work 2 days in exchange for the new member 1st year sub & levy.

Everyone can participate – whether you're a skilled tradesperson, a DIY handyperson, or neither. There are plenty of jobs for all skill levels on the ski area in summer & at the workshop in Rangiora, as well as a range of year-round jobs that can be done in the city or from home. There's huge satisfaction to be gained from helping out on projects that assist the ski club to operate smoothly. You also have a chance to meet other members and make new friends. Work party weekend details are published in club newsletters and e-bulletins. Work Days can be done while you're still considering membership or your application is pending – details are still captured. If you complete too many Work Days for your own use these may be used by others in your family - special conditions apply.
